POSITION GOALS

1. To direct and coordinate discipline program as well as effectively administer the Discipline Code for assigned students

PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Assists in operational and organizational matters within the school including student discipline
- 2. Acts on behalf of the principal in the absence of the principal of other designated office in NJSIAA, conference, or other athletic and co-curricular proceedings
- 3. Implement appropriate communication forms and procedures whereby lines of communication are maintained between the instructional staff and the home/school office relative to a discipline case
- 4. Maintains a good working relationship with faculty and student body
- 5. To provide for and maintain disciplinary action that is beneficial in modifying student behavior
- 6. To solicit parental input in the decision making process where deemed efficient and appropriate
- 7. To assist in the smooth operation of the total school program in such areas as school facilities, professional and non-professional personnel and educational programs in conjunction with or in the absence of the school principal
- 8. Performs such other duties which are within the scope of his/her employment and certifications as assigned by the

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principal, subject to the approval of the Superintendent of Schools, in accordance with New Jersey State law, State Board of Education rules and regulations, and Glassboro Board of Education

Added items of responsibility:

- 9. Supervise student behavior in both cafeterias prior to the start of classes; 7:30am 7:50am.
- 10. Supervise student behavior in cafeterias during lunches 11:25am 11:55am; 12:25pm 12:55pm.
- 11. Monitor students between change of each instructional block
- 12. Supervise C hall and bus pick-up area at the end of each day until students have been picked up
- 13. Supervise and monitor student lunch privileges for the school year.
- 14. Supervise on campus parking privileges for students and staff.
