- TITLE:** Supervisor of Curriculum and Instruction

- REPORTS TO:** Director of Curriculum and works in conjunction with building Principals and district supervisors.
- SUPERVISES:** Teachers Preschool through grade 12
- SCOPE:** The Supervisor of Curriculum and Instruction coordinates the educational program in Preschool through grade 12 (including Special Education).
- POSITION GOALS:** Provide leadership and perform administrative tasks within English, to assist in planning, organizing and developing English programs in cooperation with the Principals and Director of Curriculum, and to serve as the source of expertise regarding these areas.
- PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:**
- Coordinates the District English Curriculum in grades Preschool through grade 12.
 - Assists in the development of curriculum in coordination with the Director of Curriculum at the district level.
 - Assists in the recruitment, screening, hiring, training, and assigning of instructional personnel, and makes recommendations to building principals regarding reappointment of personnel.
 - Assists in the formulation of the philosophy and objectives for English.
 - Assists in the planning and coordination of in-service programs for English.
 - Supervises, observes, and evaluates all teachers, in coordination with building Principals within English and Social Studies.

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- Assists in selection of English textbooks and instructional materials in coordination with the Director of Curriculum.
- Makes regular classroom visitations, confers with teachers, provides constructive criticism, and consults with Principals regarding departmental activities.
- Assists in the review, evaluation, and analysis of test results.
- Coordinates the publication of all curriculum guides and materials prepared by and to be distributed among English instructional staff.
- Work with building principals and teachers to identify school and classroom strengths and weaknesses.
- Attend bi-monthly County Supervisor Meetings for English and Social Studies.
- Establish and promote high standards and expectations of academic performance for all students and staff.
- Ensure that curriculum development and teaching methods support and are applicable for all learners.
- Ensure that lesson plans and instruction align with New Jersey Student Learning Standards for English and Social Studies.
- Ensure vertical and horizontal articulation of skills and content sequence between elementary and secondary buildings.
- Work cooperatively with building principals and other district administration to ensure that instructional programs and services are coordinated in the schools and are administered uniformly and equitably.
- Works closely with HS English and Social Studies department chair to oversee department needs.
- Assists in developing district goals and objectives.
- Performs such other tasks and other responsibilities as assigned.
