**Policies/Regulations 2020-2021 Restart & Recovery Plan Resolution to Reopen Schools Preschool Through Twelfth Grade** Mr. Hughes moved, seconded by Mr. Cibo that the board approve the first reading of policies and the 2020-2021 Restart and Recovery Plan to reopen schools Preschool through twelfth grade Hybrid half day schedule. The framework for this plan was developed after careful consideration of The Road Back, the NJDOE’s 104-page guidance document for the reopening of schools. The plan crafted after the completion of focus groups, community surveys, restart committees and protracted administrative discussion. The requirements outlined in the NJDOE Guidance and incorporated into this plan are controlled by Executive Order of the Governor of New Jersey and are subject to change. This plan is pending County Review.

**New Business** President Calvo moved and seconded by Mr. Cibo the board to approve the head, assistant and volunteer coaches and advisors' positions, for the fall 2020-21 school year, at the approved stipend/rate under the following conditions:

- If a Coach is notified by the Board of Education on or before August 28, 2020, (which has been defined by the NJSIAA as summer recess period), that the season has been cancelled and the season does not resume, no stipend/rate shall be paid.
- If a Coach is notified by the Board of Education on or before September 14, 2020, (which has been defined by the NJSIAA as the official start practices for the fall 2020 practice season), that the season has been cancelled and the season does not resume, coach(es) will earn and receive 20 percent of the contracted stipend;
- If any football coach is notified by the Board of Education on or before October 5, 2020, that the season has been cancelled and the season does not resume, coach(es) will earn 50 percent of the contracted stipend;
- If any coach, which the exception of football and girls tennis, is notified by the Board of Education on or before October 12 2020, that the season has been cancelled and the season does not resume, coach(es) will earn 50 percent of the contracted stipend;

- If any coach or marching band advisor, with the exception of football and girls tennis, is notified by the Board of Education on or before October 26, 2020, that the season has been cancelled and the season does not resume, coach(es) will earn 75 percent of the contracted stipend;
