

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN
Rowan College of South Jersey, and
Glassboro High School**

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (the "Memorandum") made on March 1, 2024 by and between Rowan College of South Jersey ("RCSJ"), and Glassboro High School ("High School") shall set forth the expressed intentions of the parties to create a partnership agreement as described herein.

1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 The purpose of this Memorandum is to provide for the beginning of discussions or the framework for the creation of a Collegiate High School Partnership (the "Partnership") between RCSJ and High School. It is not intended to set forth all of the essential or material terms of an agreement and is, therefore, not legally binding.

1.1.1 The Partnership is described as follows: RCSJ intends to form the Partnership to provide secondary education students with the curriculum, experiences, preparation and opportunities they need to confidently transition to their post-secondary education and career goals.

2.0 COOPERATION

2.1 The activities and services for the proposed Partnership are anticipated to include the following responsibilities or obligations to be performed by the respective parties as identified below:

2.1.1 High School: High School will provide opportunity for credit-bearing courses, enrichment opportunities, and support services on their campus. High School will facilitate the communication of the Partnership offerings by distributing Partnership marketing materials and by hosting informational sessions on site. High School will provide RCSJ with access to students and a workspace to support advisement. High School will give consideration to making dual enrollment accessible to students by offering an "RCSJ period" to allow students to complete online coursework and/or by providing transportation to RCSJ to complete lecture and lab-based courses. High School will give consideration to finding funding sources to offer financial support to students. High School will encourage collaboration and connection with RCSJ faculty and staff.

2.1.2 Rowan College of South Jersey: RCSJ will provide students with intensive educational experiences, high school equivalency education & testing, dual enrollment and degree completion opportunities, and access to Pathway Programs. RCSJ will provide Summer Bridge programming, Student Ambassador programming & scholarship opportunities, college advisement, career coaching and assistance with FAFSA completion for regulatory compliance. Enrolled students will have access to the college's educational and recreational facilities and support services to further promote their identification with and involvement in the college community. RCSJ will encourage collaboration and connection with High School faculty and staff.

3.0 RESOURCES

3.1 It is anticipated that High School may provide the following resources with respect to the proposed Program:

- Facilities
- Personnel
- Counseling
- Student Interest Surveys
- Individualized Student Plan
- Credit Courses and Participating Faculty
- Funding for Credit Bearing Courses.
- Enrichment Opportunities
- Display and distribute as appropriate the provided Marketing and Communications materials.

3.2 It is anticipated that RCSJ may provide the following resources with respect to the proposed Program:

- Facilities
- Personnel
- Collegiate Advisement
- Career Coaching
- FAFSA assistance for parents & students
- Student Scholarships
- Reduced Tuition costs
- Guest speaker opportunities within identified fields of study
- Visitations to RCSJ
- Marketing and Communication Materials, that display the full name and official logo of Rowan, to best promote the Partnership via internal communication vehicles and public relations.


4.0 DURATION


