MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT REPORT

The month of January provided plenty of times to have to deal with slippery conditions. The custodial and grounds staff has done a very good job so far keeping the facilities and the perimeter sidewalks as safe as possible. One storm provided just enough snow to need to be plowed away while the others required salt. Heating issues continue to be a concern as our equipment has reached its life expectancy many years ago. The maintenance staff continues to patch and do what they can to keep the systems operating.

In addition the following tasks were completed by our maintenance staff:

Glassboro High School

- 1. Painted and caulked behind the replacement toilet in the main office lavatory.
- 2. Made adjustments to the heating system for the science wing.
- 3. Adjusted the thermostat for room A-105.
- 4. Replaced the drive belt for the unit ventilator in room A-109.
- 5. Installed an electrical outlet for the new copier in the library.
- 6. Cleared one sink drain in the science wing.
- 7. Replaced backflow preventers and caps on the custodial chemical cleaning solution machine.
