### MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT REPORT

The start to the new school year went well. The air conditioning systems continued to have to work extremely hard with the high outdoor air temperatures. The facilities looked nice and fresh thanks to the hard work of the custodial staff. One of our maintenance men has been out sick and the other maintenance man has been doing his best to keep up with the demand. We have been prioritizing the work since we have been down to just one man. The grounds staff was busy attempting to keep the athletic fields watered so the athletes had some form of a cushion to practice and play on.

In addition the following tasks were completed by our maintenance staff:

**Glassboro High School** 

- 1. Turned on all gas to kitchen appliances and lit pilots.
- 2. Made repairs to the above ground sprinkler system for the athletic fields.
- 3. Replaced five light ballasts in the back hallway.
- 4. Repaired the air handler in room C-104.
- 5. Repaired the unit ventilator in room B-103.
- 6. Repaired the air conditioning for rooms C-103 and C-105.
- 7. Installed temporary air conditioners in rooms C-103 and C-104.
- 8. Raised two sprinkler heads on the varsity football field.
- 9. Repaired the air handler in room A-131.
- 10. Repaired the wiring for the air conditioning unit for room C-106.
- 11. Replaced the drive bearing in the unit ventilator for room B-104.
- 12. Serviced the drive bearings for the air handlers in rooms A-131 and A-132.
- 13. Replaced burned out lamps in the football field scoreboard.
- 14. Provided new room keys for rooms A-118 and A-139.
- 15. Installed one bulletin board in room A-105.
- 16. Repaired the unit ventilator in room B-103.
- 17. Replaced two light ballasts in room B-103.
- 18. Replaced one light ballast in room C-110.

- 19. Replaced four light tubes, four light bulbs and two light ballasts in the school store.
- 20. Replaced the stove in the concession stand with a good used one from the home ec. room.
- 21. Repaired the fittings for the chemical feed pump for the chiller tower.
- 22. Repaired one custodial vacuum.
- 23. Restored power for the projector touch pad in the sound booth at the auditorium.
- 24. Disconnected the 220 volt power for the UPS batteries in the technology closet.
- 25. Replaced the legs on one table in room C-109.
- 26. Replaced one light ballast on the girl's side of the gym.
- 27. Reattached falling banners in the gym.
- 28. Cleared one toilet in the C-wing female lavatory.
- 29. Cleared the condensation drain for the media center air handler.
- 30. Reattached pads on the gym wall.

# Intermediate School

- 1. Reset the compressor for the chiller.
- 2. Turned gas on to all appliances in the kitchen and lit pilots.
- 3. Replaced the photocell on one from exterior wall pack light.
- 4. Repaired leaking flush valves on toilets for the first floor male lavatory.
- 5. Replaced the light switch for room 204.
- 6. Replaced vacuum breakers on toilets in the first and third floor female lavatories.
- 7. Disconnected the 200 volt UPS batteries in the technology closet.
- 8. Replaced the faucet for the hand wash sink in the kitchen.
- 9. Checked the serving line for water leaks.
- 10. Replaced the lamp for the exterior wall pack light by the kitchen.

Thomas Bowe School

- 9. Replaced the door closer for room B-122.

- 9. Repaired toilets in the lavatory by room A-14.
- 10. Repaired the toilet in the lavatory for room D-7.
- 11. Disconnected the 220 volt UPS battery back up in the technology closet.
- 12. Replaced the filters for the air handlers in the gym and cafeteria.
- 13. Replaced one 400 watt lamp in the gym.
