MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT REPORT

The month of April was a busy one for the grounds staff. Spring sports were in full swing and the grass at all the facilities really started growing with all the rain. They are doing a nice job handling all of their responsibilities. The maintenance mechanics spent time readying the facilities for the switch from heat to air conditioning.

The following assignments were completed by our staff:

Glassboro High School

- 1. Replaced the ceiling tile and smoke detector that had been water damaged.
- 2. Cleared the sink trap and drain in the little bulldogs room.
- 3. Replaced the faucet mounts and supply lines to the prep sink in the kitchen.
- 4. Turned the water supply on for the baseball field faucet.
- 5. Cleared the sewer line for the science wing and cleaned the pit and pumps.
- 6. Turned water supply on for the concession stand.
- 7. Cleared two toilets in the female lavatory by room A-116.
- 8. Made repairs to water piping damaged this winter.
- 9. Repaired the water supply for the chiller cooling tower.
- 10. Replaced one light ballast and three light tubes in room A-109.
- 11. Repaired one light fixture cover in room A-105.
- 12. Replaced one light ballast and two light tubes in the main entrance.
- 13. Cleaned out the chiller tower and water lines to get ready to start the chiller.
- 14. Replaced the drive belt for the main office air handler.
- 15. Greased all pumps and motors in the boiler room.
- 16. Cleared the drain for the A-wing water fountain.
- 17. Replaced the exhaust fan unit on the boy's locker room roof.
- 18. Replaced two grates on the unit ventilator in room A-118.
- 19. Replaced the clock in room C-110.
- 20. Checked for roof leaks throughout the building.
- 21. Repaired one file cabinet in the guidance area.
- 22. Caulked window sills in rooms around the courtyard area.

- 23. Repaired one cabinet in room A-139.
- 24. Repaired the classroom door lock for room A-135.
- 25. Removed a broken lock from the teacher's desk in room A-134.

Intermediate School

- 1. Replaced two lamps in the first floor male lavatory.
- 2. Removed the motor and motor coupling from the unit ventilator in room 213.
- 3. Replaced worn parts on the first floor custodial chemical dispenser.
- 4. Replaced twenty five light tubes and two light ballasts in the faculty dining room.
- 5. Repaired the clock in room 302.
- 6. Replaced light tubes in room 210.
- 7. Replaced the motor and coupler for the unit ventilator in room 213.
- 8. Repaired the light fixture in the first floor female lavatory.
- 9. Shut down and closed the valves off for one boiler for the season.
- 10. Replaced broken floor tiles in room 210.

- 1. Checked the rooftop HVAC units every day and reset as needed.

- 4. Made repairs to the automatic floor scrubber.
- 5. Replaced one 250 watt lamp on the exterior kitchen wall.
- 6. Performed additional repairs to the front loop storm drain.
- 7. Repaired malfunctioning door handles for rooms C-113, C-144 and B-144.

- 1. Replaced the strainer and drain tail for one three compartment sink in the kitchen.
- 2. Repaired one custodial vacuum cleaner.

- 10. Checked for noise on the HVAC controls air compressor.
