MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT REPORT

The month of was basically uneventful for the maintenance department. After the winter we experienced the lack of emergencies was welcome for a change. The heating systems continued to hold on as many mornings were still cold. Contractors have begun to come into the buildings after hours to begin measuring and planning for the upcoming construction. The grounds staff continued keeping our athletic fields in competition condition for our spring sports.

In addition the following tasks were completed by our maintenance staff:

Glassboro High School

- 1. Performed an emergency transfer of the generator to check for emergency circuit operation.
- 2. Made repairs to the emergency lights in the gym.
- 3. Reset the upright standards for the high jump event.
- 4. Replaced the lamp in the science wing wall pack light.
- 5. Replaced three light ballasts and two light tubes in the cafeteria.
- 6. Repaired one custodial chemical cleaning dispensing unit.
- 7. Repaired the unit ventilator in the little bulldog's room.
- 8. Began spring change out of air filters in the unit ventilators.
- 9. Replaced the drive belts for the main office and media center air handlers.
- 10. Performed preventative maintenance on the roof units and the auditorium air handler.
