The following tasks were completed by our maintenance staff:

Glassboro High School

- 1. Replaced one light ballast in the main hall male lavatory.
- 2. Replaced the cord end on one computer cart in room A-122.
- 3. Re hung the "No food or drink" sign over the girl's side gym entrance.
- 4. Reset the heating unit for room A-102 and A-107.
- 5. Replaced four burned out lamps in the gym.
- 6. Replaced the blower motor for the unit ventilator in room A-136.
- 7. Replaced the filters in the air handlers for rooms A-102 and A-107.
- 8. Replaced the flush valve and relief valve of the staff lavatory in the TV hallway.
- 9. Replaced one light ballast in the gym.
- 10. Removed balls from on top of the air handlers.
