#### MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT REPORT

The Maintenance Department has continued changing the air filters in all the air handlers and unit ventilators for spring and to get the equipment ready to switch to the cooling season as well as completing work orders as received from the facilities. The grounds staff have remained very busy keeping up with spring sports as well as maintaining all the grass at the district facilities.

The following tasks were completed by our maintenance staff:

#### Glassboro High School

- 1. Extended the vent for the sewer stack near the pump room.
- 2. Cleared a clogged toilet in the C-wing male lavatory.
- 3. Washed down the pit for the grinder pumps for the sewer lift station.
- 4. Had contractor respond to make emergency repair to one set of gym bleachers.
- 5. Secured the plumbing chase door by room A-113.
- 6. Replaced one faucet in the boy's lavatory near the gym entrance.
- 7. Tested the stand by generator and inspected the exit signs and emergency lighting.
- 8. Restored power to the C-wing exhaust fans.
- 9. Repaired a table in room A-131.
- 10. Replaced the light in one custodial closet.
- 11. Restored power to the pneumatic unit ventilators in the A-wing.
- 12. Rebuilt the flush valve for the toilet in the male coach's office.
