MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT REPORT

The following tasks were completed by our maintenance staff during the month:

Glassboro High School

- 1. Repaired the boy's locker room exhaust fan.
- 2. Replaced the photo cell on the pole light at the back drive.
- 3. Cleared the water fountain drain for the mechanical contractor installing the new water fountains.
- 4. Repaired the wall pads in the auxiliary gym.
- 5. Tested the stand by generator and inspected the exit signs and emergency lighting.
- 6. Checked for power to the exterior gym lights.
- 7. Replaced five faucets in the female lavatory at the science wing.
- 8. Repaired toilets in the boy's locker room.
- 9. Replaced the faucet for the two compartment sink in the kitchen.
- 10. Replaced the toilet seat for the lavatory inside the nurse's office.
- 11. Cleared the drain for the gym custodial closet.
- 12. Changed filters in the main office and auditorium air handlers.
- 13. Removed white board in room A-132.
- 14. Installed a new toilet in the boy's locker room lavatory.
- 15. Lit all kitchen equipment pilot lights.
- 16. Changed filters in all classroom units.
