MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT REPORT

The month of October gave us our first real test of our heating systems. The buildings were switched to heat to cover cold mornings and the systems switched over from cooling with relatively minor issues. With our equipment being so old there will be continuing issues with temperature comfort but heat at least works in all of the facilities. The grounds staff continued to work hard at keeping both our athletic fields and our facilities looking good as the fall season approached.

In addition the following tasks were completed by our maintenance staff:

Glassboro High School

- 1. Replaced one light ballast in room A-133.
- 2. Replaced one light ballast and three light tubes in the front hall.
- 3. Made repairs to the water supply for the main hall female lavatory.
- 4. Replaced one broken toilet seat in the boy's locker room lavatory.
- 5. Repaired the toilet in the main hall female lavatory.
- 6. Replaced one faucet in the female lavatory by room A-116.
- 7. Replaced the belt for the exhaust fan controlling the lavatory by room A-107.
- 8. Replaced one electrical outlet in room A-122.
- 9. Replaced one light ballast and five light tubes in the TV studio.
- 10. Replaced sixteen light tubes and three light ballasts in the faculty work room.
- 11. Checked temperature issue in room A-113.
- 12. Replaced one light ballast and four light tubes in room C-109.
- 13. Replaced two light ballasts and four light tubes in room C-108.
- 14. Replaced two light ballasts in each cafeteria.

- 29. Replaced forty one light tubes and two light ballasts in the back hall classrooms.
- 30. Replaced two drive bearings and the drive motor for the C-wing lavatory exhaust fan.
- 31. Replaced three light tubes for the top of the front lawn school sign.
- 32. Removed, repaired and replaced the tires on the automatic floor scrubber.
- 33. Replaced one tennis court net.
- 34. Changed out banners in the cafeterias.
- 35. Mounted the Will Gallon tribute plaque in the main hall.
- 36. Replaced hasps and installed new locks on the A-wing circuit breaker boxes.
- 37. Replaced the door threshold for the faculty work room.
- 38. Switched all valves from cooling to heating in the boiler room and front hall.
- 39. Replaced broken boards on the press box observation deck.
- 40. Repaired the floor in the C-wing male lavatory.

- 4. Turned the burners on for all of the rooftop HVAC units.
- 5. Replaced four exterior wall pack lamps.
- 6. Installed two replacement exhaust fan motors.
- 7. Replaced the ballast, lamp and photocell for the light at the cafeteria entrance.
- 8. Replaced one toilet seat in the 6^{th} grade boy's lavatory.
- 9. Replaced one toilet seat and repaired one seat hardware for the staff lavatory.
- 10. Replaced the bubbler button for the water fountain for the 6^{th} grade.
- 11. Repaired one custodial vacuum.
- 12. Repaired one toilet flush valve in the nurse's office.
- 13. Mounted AED signs at various locations.
- 14. Removed and changed the location of the exterior door sweep for the music room.
- 15. Repaired one stall door in the 6^{th} grade boy's lavatory.
- 16. Installed paper holders in the main office.
