District Wide Projects

High School

- High School Press Box repairs just about complete, cost about \$700.00, doing finishing touches. Need to fix the siding in the summer which was done with soffit covering not siding. One other issue and will be fixed over the summer, original work on the upper section roof hatch, the way it opens and how the steps go up make it a fall hazard. We will rotate the hatch to open and the other way making it easier to go up the steps and get onto the roof.
- Graduation and work on the Stadium continues with some removal of old bushes and new stencils in to mark the endzones with BULLDOGS, GLASSBORO and the center of the field with a large G and painted school colors.
- Donated benches for the tennis courts have arrived, need to be put together and installed on the courts. Have reached out to the Township regarding proper way to install on the new surface.
- Gross Construction is supposed to start work on the Aux Gym anytime, just waiting on dates.

GIS

- Fire Inspection revealed a room with a hot water heater had no CO Detector in it, contacted George Duthie. Temporary battery-operated CO detectors placed there and, in the spaces, surrounding that room. See not under District wide regarding fire alarm monitoring/repairs.

Bowe

- Parts in for hot water boiler and is being scheduled to repair, this will happen over the summer due to the amount of work just to take the unit apart, so we do not disrupt hot water for the building.

Bullock

- NetZero LED lighting continues to be installed in the building. About 85% complete and should be done before end of summer. Then process to get final approval and have funds returned.

Rodgers

- Burger Fence has put us on their schedule to make repairs to gate and fence.

Beach Admin.

- Need to talk about roof replacement at Beach, possibly for Bond Referendum.

DISTRICT WIDE

- Pitman Schools will be lending us a golf cart on June 16th to help drive those who may need help to access the stadium for graduation, pending they do not need it due to rain date. We will also be using the trainers golf cart as well as the grounds cart to help.
- rSchooltoday electronic work orders up and running, since we started 211 work orders have been generated and approximately 18 still outstanding. Over the summer I will start to create PM and HAVC maintenance work orders. Also give more accurate locations for the items that need to be fixed so maintenance can go directly to the problem and not ask where.
- Due to issues with Franklin Alarm and not responding to issue in a timely manor I have requested Quotes from other companies. Depending on Lisa Ridgway's approval Wayman Fire Protection will take over July 1st.
