District Wide Projects

High School

- Misc. TV TECH equipment was sold on GovDeals.
- Received a new stand on floor scrubber along with a new wet/dry vacuum, part of the 3 year zero % interest lease through Hillyard and Tennant.

- PAC Building boilers fixed and running.

Bowe

- It has been discovered that some Bowe rooftop units are again having issues with their fire boxes having CO leaks. This is a repeat from 2017/2019 where Northeast Mechanical custom-made burner box for the same problem back in 2017 and then again in 2019. We have one unit shut down now and possible three others having small but similar issues. We have reinstalled all battery-operated CO meters along with the CO system just recently installed in junction with the fire alarm to make sure we don't have any CO problems in the building.
- Received a new stand on floor scrubber along as well as a new carpet extractor and a new wet/dry vacuum, part of the 3 year zero % interest lease through Hillyard and Tennant.
- Bowe gym roof leak was worked on by USA General Contracting. Will inspect to see if leaks have stopped with the help from Garland Roofing.

Bullock

- Received a new stand on floor scrubber along with a new wet/dry vacuum, part of the 3 year zero % interest lease through Hillyard and Tennant.
- Final application has started for closure of the NET ZERO LED Project. Once NJ Clean Energy receives the application, we may get an inspection and once that is cleared our total amount on the original PO will be returned to the district.

- Received a new carpet extractor and a new wet/dry vacuum, part of the 3 year zero % interest lease through Hillyard and Tennant.
- Coil repairs made to damaged coils after freezing up.
