# **High School**

• Old lighting from TV Tech room has been removed, will be sold on GovDeals then scrapped if no one purchases them.

# GIS

- Pipe leak about plaster ceiling room 207. Hot water line insulated with asbestos. EDI called to handle air samples and removal. Pipe repaired after all clear from asbestos removal. Room will be put back together after we are sure all is dry.
- Water leak from 3<sup>rd</sup> floor bathroom, flooding that room and working its way down to third floor. Cleaned up as soon as we were notified and discovered open hot water valve. Maintenance forgot about this pipe when hot water was shut off for original leak. All cleaned up and everything fixed.

#### Bowe

- 2 Mammoth RTUs to be replaced by Core Mechanical at a price of \$457,380.00.
- Seasons 4 and Core Mechanical have been to Bowe to take down measurements for new units.
- A separate inspection report regarding the Mammoth RTUs was conducted by CM3 as soon as I receive the report it will be given to Lisa Ridgway to give to the committee.

#### Bullock

• Dormann Plumbing has received the two Pos for the replacement hot water heaters under and emergency issue.

#### Rodgers

• Several units in the building were repaired with new valves, one cafeteria unit needs new coil, have a company coming out to give us a cost on making new coil.
