



SIEKSEY HALL OF A LASE


Designed by internationally renowned architect Michael Graves and museum consultants Ralph Appelbaum Associates, the exhibit is truly state-of-the-art with interactive computers, instructional opportunities and artifacts.





When on theoad, the trailer is the standard 8.6 feet wide by 53 feet long. Once parked at an exhibit location, the trailer expands from both sides opening up to 23.4 feet wide by 36.5 feet long. The height is 13.5 feet.

Each exhibit object highlights important chapters in the evolution of social, economi scientific, cultural, and political progress for which these iconic New Jersey figures are known.



The mobile museum is available to travel throughout the entire state, all year long for educators. The exhibit is also available for corporate and private events.

The mobile museum may be reserved on a full day basis providing time for all grade levels to visit. The museum may remain open for families and other community groups to enjoy and learn from the exhibits after school hours.
