Enclosed is your school district's 2014-2015 New Jersey School Boards Association membership dues invoice. Dues are calculated through a formula adopted by the membership at the November 22, 2003 Delegate Assembly. The formula is designed to align dues so that they accurately reflect the comparative size of school district budgets.

The Board of Directors has voted to freeze 2014-2015 dues at the amount paid in 2013-2014. Your district dues calculation for 2014-2015 is:

Dues enable NJSBA to provide the valuable services needed by all local school boards:

Energy Savings – Since 2009, the New Jersey School Boards Association's Alliance for Competitive Energy Services (ACES)—available to your board through its NJSBA membership—has provided school districts with *more than \$150 million in savings* on electricity. For the years 2013-14 and 2014-15, ACES districts will enjoy \$46.8 million in energy savings, an amount three times greater than NJSBA dues for the same period

Advocacy – NJSBA helped preserve local school board authority and financial flexibility by—

- *Saving school boards \$7.4 million* per year by advocating the elimination of increases in state assessments for school construction grants.
- *Providing more than \$1 million in potential savings* by helping to pass a new law that gives districts no-cost access to claims data from the School Employee Health Benefits Program. Previously, school boards had to pay for the information, which can be essential in identifying a health insurance carrier.
