Enclosed is your school district's 2017-2018 New Jersey School Boards Association (NJSBA) membership dues invoice.

For the eighth consecutive year, the NJSBA Board of Directors adopted a budget that calls for no dues increase. Your district's 2017-2018 dues remain at the same level as the previous year:

**Glassboro Bd of Ed
\$14,779.34**

The NJSBA dues structure was adopted by the NJSBA membership through the Delegate Assembly.

Dues enable NJSBA to provide the valuable services needed by all local school boards.

- In the eight-year period ending June 2017, NJSBA's Alliance for Competitive Energy Services (ACES), our energy-buying cooperative, saved member school districts more than \$202.3 million. In 2016-2017 alone, ACES savings exceeded \$30 million. For each of the 409 participating school districts, the savings averaged \$73,350 – an amount *almost six times greater than annual dues*. ACES will continue to be a major benefit of NJSBA membership next year.
- NJSBA dues give districts access to high-quality direct services. These services include teacher contract analysis, negotiations consultation, and on-demand telephone information from our staff attorneys. Our field service representatives go onsite to local school boards over 1,900 times each year to deliver training and consultation in effective school board governance. Districts pay no additional fees for these services. The long-term benefit of these dues-supported services comes in the form of *controlling compensation, avoiding litigation and attaining educational goals*.

- Annually over half of the state's local school board members participate in the governance training required by the New Jersey School Ethics and School District Accountability Acts. NJSBA dues fully cover the program development and delivery of the in-person and online training designed to meet this requirement, resulting in no additional expenditures by school boards.

NJSBA remains committed to meeting the needs of local school boards and individual board members in the areas of professional development, consultation and advocacy.

Although state law (*N.J.S.A. 18A:6-50*) requires all boards to belong to NJSBA, the Association's policies, bylaws and dues structure are established through a democratic process and must be approved by vote of the NJSBA membership at the Delegate Assembly.
