Re: Resolution – Auditing Services


The NJ Schools Insurance Group awards school districts grant allotments from the underwriting surplus for the previous program year. This year the allotment awarded to the Glassboro School District is \$8,979.00. The application for the grant has been submitted, it is recommended that the board ratify the following resolution recognizing the application submission to NJSIG. The project description is as follows:

- 1. The purchase of two Raptor Visitor Management Kiosks for the Intermediate and High Schools. This will enable the facilitation of visitor sign in, screening and the ability to produce visitor badges in a contactless manner. The Kiosks will reside in the security vestibule and the visitor will not be allowed entry into the school building until completing the process and receiving clearance. GHS has a designated greeter; at Intermediate it will be Debbie Kersey (security aide). The systems are portable. Attached are two informational items about the kiosk system and a short demo video of the kiosk can be viewed through this link: Open
- 2. The purchase of Exit Stopper Multifunction Door Alarms for Double Doors. This not only presents a visual warning to anyone trying to open exterior doors from the inside of the building but also an alarm will sound if the doors have been opened. This allows the district to have additional safety and security measures, preventing staff or students form opening or propping open doors that should remain closed. Please see attachment.
- 3. The purchase of a Portable Lockout Kit (Electrical/Valve) to protect all stakeholders. The lockout kit provides a wide range of lockout applications, and the kit provides necessary components to ensure that equipment is either de-energized or locked out in accordance with OSHA regulation 1910.47. CONTACTLESS VISITOR MANAGEMENT: Assisted Main Office Check-In with Kiosk







Traditional Assisted Check-In

- In a traditional set up, both the Raptor ID Scanner and the Raptor Badge Printer are placed next to the front office staff.
- Each visitor hands a government issued photo ID to the front office staff who then inserts the photo ID into the Raptor ID Scanner.
- After scanning and screening, the front office staff hands back both the photo ID and the printed visitor badge to the visitor.

Contactless Assisted Check-In with a Kiosk

- For contactless check-in with kiosk option, the Raptor Self-Service Kiosk is placed at least six feet from the front office staff and in front of the visitor. Ideally a plexiglass shield or similar separates the front office staff from the visitor.
- The visitor scans his or her government issued photo ID with the Raptor Self-Service Kiosk built-in ID scanner, selects the destination, and enters responses to optional custom health questions used by the school.
- First time visitors may take their photo with the builtin webcam directly at the kiosk. Face masks can be removed for this process as it only takes a few seconds.

Contactless Badge Hand-off

- Once the visitor is approved, office staff clicks "Submit & Print" and a visitor badge will print out next to the office staff.
- The badge should be placed under or to the side of the shield by the front office staff and retrieved by the visitor maintaining at least a six foot distance.



STUDENT MODULE
