


Nutrition Education: Balloons for a Balanced Lunch BINGO

How To Play:

The game can be played in one of two ways...

- 1. **BINGO** can be a student getting a row of foods going in any direction—horizontal, vertical and diagonal.
- 2. **BINGO** must be a complete lunch so it can be *horizontal* or *vertical*.

Goals & Objectives

- Categorize foods into the school lunch food groups.
- Recognize food combinations that make a complete lunch or USDA reimbursable meal.
- Learn the Nutri-Serve nutrition education concept Balloons for a Balanced Lunch where each school lunch food group is represented by a different balloon color.
