Re: Resolution – Alyssa’s Law/School Security Grant

On December 16, 2020, the Board passed a resolution approving the submission and acceptance upon approval of the 2020-21 Security Grant in the amount of \$104,313. The state has decided that they would like language added to the resolution and all districts that have applied for the Alyssa’s Law/School Security Grant must approve a new resolution that contains mandated language. Our application for the grant has been approved pending the passage of the new resolution.

New Resolution

Be It Resolved that the Glassboro Board of Education does hereby recognize submission of the Alyssa’s Law/School Security Grant application as approved on December 16, 2020. The purpose of this grant application is to purchase additional strobes, readers, door controllers, replacement doors and additional cameras for the district in the amount not to exceed \$104,313; and

Be It Further Resolved that the Glassboro Board of Education affirms the submission of the grant application and if it is determined that the proposed work exceeds the school districts’ grant allocation that there would either be local funds available or modify the scope of work to be performed.
