Naming of the Early Childhood Development Center at Rowan University

WHEREAS, the Board of Education recognizes and celebrates Nicholas Mitcho's years of dedicated and distinguished service as Superintendent of Schools, during which he welcomed Ronald Reagan to Glassboro High School, led the district into a new era of excellence, actively contributed to numerous local organizations that strengthened both the Borough and school community, played a key role in establishing the Glassboro Education Foundation, and is remembered for his lasting legacy as a respected and beloved superintendent; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education recognizes and celebrates Carmen Mitcho's years of dedicated and distinguished service as Principal of Thomas E. Bowe School, where he demonstrated an unwavering commitment to teaching and learning, served the community's children with compassion and purpose, earned the admiration and respect of colleagues and families for his work with economically disadvantaged students, and led efforts that resulted in the successful implementation of the Renaissance program and the construction of a new playground; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education desires to formally recognize the Mitcho family for their enduring commitment, support, and contributions to the students and community of Glassboro Public Schools, both during their years of service and throughout their well-earned retirements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Glassboro Board of Education hereby approves the official naming of the upcoming Early Childhood Development Center located at Rowan University as

“The Mitcho Early Childhood Center”

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this designation shall become effective July 1, 2026.
