ACADEMICS

Upon successful completion of the STEAM Academy, students earn three transferable, college-level, Rowan University credits. Course offerings are designed for students at each grade level and focus on Science, Technology, Engineering, the Arts and/or Mathematics.

RESIDENTIAL COLLEGE EXPERIENCE

During the STEAM Academy's 3-week program, students stay in supervised, on-campus housing and dine in Rowan's cafeteria and at local restaurants. They utilize other campus facilities such as the Recreation and Student Center.

LEADERSHIP TRAINING

Dynamic presentations by Rowan faculty coupled with workshops on leadership topics help students develop their skills. Specific areas included are self-evaluation, emotional intelligence, problem-solving, goal setting, decision making, giving and responding effectively to feedback and recognizing others' contributions. Communication, group dynamics and diversity in leadership are also covered.

COLLEGE & CAREER PLANNING

The STEAM Academy students will attend seminars led by Rowan University's Office of Career Advancement and complete the FOCUS II, a personality and skills inventory. The counselors will also help students plan for the remainder of their high school years through the development of a comprehensive Action Plan. The students and counselors will work together to use results from FOCUS II to create an attainable plan for their academic and career goals. The Action plan will be used by the students to identify and explore college majors and career options.

In addition, STEAM Academy students will conduct research on potential and applicable careers. Upon completion of the Academy, they will have completed a personalized and professional resume. Seniors will also improve their interview skills through mock interviews.

COUNSELING

The STEAM Academy is supported by trained counselors that help provide students with a well-rounded experience. This includes personal, academic, and career development as well as individualized guidance. Counselors assist students with living on campus, being away from home, and becoming more independent. Students are also supported through structured study groups to assist with preparing for the rigorous demands of the college level coursework. Career development is explored through the completion of the Action Plan in coordination with the Office of Career Advancement.



TIMELINE

- December 2015 February 2016: Complete the application form and submit all materials. Space is limited and students are strongly encouraged to apply early to ensure a spot.
- April 15, 2016: Admission and scholarship decisions about STEAM Academy 2016 will be sent by this date.
- April June 2016: Admitted students will receive a follow-up package of information, including details about
 the program, a schedule, and additional forms to complete. The forms will include an acceptance contract,
 a liability waiver, photography/film waiver, and health insurance/medical information forms, all of which are
 required to be signed and submitted before the program begins.
- May 22, 2016: Mandatory orientation on Rowan's campus
- July 10, 2016: The 3-week residential program begins.

- · High school transcripts
- Brief autobiographical sketch (100-200 words) that includes personal background and characteristics
- Essay (200-250 words, typed) explaining interest in attending the STEAM Academy
- Optional submission of standardized test scores (PSAT, SAT, ACT)

Incomplete applications will not be considered. Applicants applying by the deadline will be notified of admission to the program by April 15. Applicants applying after the deadline will be placed on a waiting list and will be notified of admission only if space is available. Acceptance letters will be sent directly to participants.

If accepted into the 2016 STEAM Academy, students and their parents or guardians will be invited to attend a mandatory orientation. A program overview will be provided along with STEAM requirements, materials and expectations.
