Requesting Board approval for Glassboro's MD self-contained classrooms to participate in Rowan University's Get FIT Program. Get FIT is an initiative of the Family Resource Network (FRN) to improve access to wellness programs for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD), such as autism and epilepsy, and their caregivers. The get FIT @ school is a new initiative to provide resources and training to teachers of inclusion classrooms and schools to enable them to provide effective wellness programs for students with disabilities.

Both the Bowe School and the High School are invited to receive the program and have a Get FIT consultant meet twice a week for 12 weeks with the participating teachers and their students, training them to use the program in the Spring of 2015. The program will be offered free of charge to the schools with all materials provided through Rowan University.
