Recommend Board approval for the GIS SIG Summer Enrichment Program Proposed dates June 21, 2021 – July 15, 2021

Up to 30 students, 8 teachers and 2 Supervisors

Transportation cost of \$1440 (not covered by the grant)

Meal/Snack to be supplied through the Glassboro Summer Feeding Program (not covered by the grant)

Details and ramifications:

The teachers will develop and implement a curriculum to increase student achievement. Teachers will work in person with students on ELA and Math skills that have been identified as a need for those students invited to the program. Funding is provided through the SIG grant to cover planning (8 teachers 12hrs each) instruction (8 teachers 5hrs/day for 16 days) and supervision. To provide basic skills instruction to increase reading comprehension, vocabulary, writing, solving problems and improve standardized and benchmark test scores.

Positives:

Target the deficiencies and increase proficiency in Math and ELA skills for students attending Intermediate school in September 2021.

Students will return in September better prepared for the school year.

Concerns:

Many more than 30 students are in need of this added instruction and assistance, CDC guidelines have us decreasing numbers in person at this time
