Positive Action Exploratory Curriculum Writing

The Positive Action Primary Plan works toward increasing academic achievement as it prepares students to learn and be engaged in the classroom. These efforts focus the entire school on the importance of positive behavior, enhance the core curriculum and create an optimal learning environment. Intellectual positive actions, including thinking skills, are addressed at each grade level in the second unit. Subsequent units build upon these intellectual positive actions and develop the skills necessary for effective lifelong learning.

To assist in educating the whole child, instilling positive values as well as working in groups, connecting academic learning to real world skills, a Positive Actions Exploratory block will happen at the end of each school day. In order for these new courses to occur, it is necessary for staff to develop age appropriate curriculum with assessments. Staff will be using 200 total hours available develop curriculum for the Exploratory block courses. Staff progress will be monitored by the Grant Coordinator and Teaching Coach.
