Seeds to Success Youth Farm Stand

- a) Recommend Board approval of Robert Hemmes, Barbara Jones and Patricia Conn as facilitators for the Seeds to Success program for a maximum of 165 shared hours at a Miscellaneous Pay Rate, currently \$39.00 per hour, beginning July 5, 2022, through August 4, 2022.
