**Board Action Requested:** I am requesting permission to allow GHS to be a host site for the Seeds to Success Program. I recommend Board approval of Barbara Jones as Facilitator for the Seeds to Success program for a maximum of 100 hours at the current miscellaneous pay rate, beginning July 12, 2016 – August 11, 2016. Mrs. Jones' responsibilities will consist of working at the farm stand for 5 weeks, 6 hours per day, 3 days a week and completing paperwork.

I also recommend Board approval of Robert Hemmes as Assistant Facilitator for the Seeds to Success program for a maximum of 65 hours at the current miscellaneous pay rate beginning July 12, 2016 – August 11, 2016. Mr. Hemmes will assist with the supervising and working of the farm stand and allow for Mrs. Jones to receive a daily lunch break and make bank deposits.

### Details and ramifications:

Due to site construction, the stand will be moved in front of the Beach Administration building and supplies will be stored in the large conference room.

Prior to June 15, 2016, the stand items will be moved to Beach for storage in the large conference room so that they will not be in the way of the referendum project at GHS.

**Positives:** Students learn workplace readiness skills, customer service, and how to operate a road side farm stand business.
