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I. We see...

INTRO and CHARACTER INITIATIVE -

The Glassboro School District is an educational community marked by tradition, unity, and integrity, and operates as a family devoted to transformational learning. As one of the leaders in Pre-K through 12th Grade education, we see many wonderful things happening as part of an extraordinary vision to engage all the stakeholders in the district. Additionally, we hope to have a Community Wellness Center that supports healthy living, exercise, and nutrition.

As part of our expanding relationship with the community, we look forward to working with Rowan University and other outside organizations, whereby we can form partnerships and utilize and share resources. We imagine a district where high school students can earn college credits to enhance their education.

Knowing that parental involvement is critical to students' success, we see a Parents Learning Center to help parents support their children in the appropriate use of technology and social media, as well as to navigate their children's learning/academic needs, character development, and life-skills. We also see more parent resources for education and behaviors, as well as parental involvement in the school and community, including opportunities for parents to understand the evolving curriculum.

We foresee a District-wide Leadership and Professional Development Initiative that:

- Supports a growing faculty.
- Fosters the creation of Professional Learning Communities (PLCs).
- Encourages "teachers teaching teachers."
- Promotes more open-format and Socratic-methods of education.
- Engages all stakeholders in active-listening skills and other communication techniques.
- Builds a world-class professional work environment.
