<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Teacher reviews classroom-based student support interventions and implements additional supports and/ or loss of privilege</li><li>● If additional supports are needed: referral to counselor/ nurse/ case manager/ I&amp;RS Team</li><li>● Teacher/ staff member holds conference with parent/ guardian to collaborate on how best to support the student's success</li><li>● Possible in-school disciplinary consequences (lunch detention, administrative detention, denial of participation in extracurricular activities and/ or school functions)</li><li>● Possible Restitution (Students may be required to make restitution to the school district or individuals. Such restitution may include, but not be limited to: financial reimbursement, apologies or school service)</li></ul>

In addition to the disciplinary investigation, a HIB investigation conducted by our Anti-bullying specialist will be initiated by the principal to determine if a violation of the HIB Policy has occurred. Disciplinary consequences resulting from the disciplinary investigation may be administered at any time. Please note that additional discipline may be administered at the conclusion of the HIB investigation based upon the recommendations of the HIB specialist.**

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### COVID-19 ADDENDUM TO THE CODE OF CONDUCT

**Refusal to comply** - In the event of a pandemic, medical emergency, or if needed to ensure the safety of staff and students, the wearing of face masks can be required and enforced by the school. Students refusing to comply will face disciplinary action, including but not limited to, removal from school property and transportation (N.J.S.A. 18A:40-9). **After a student’s third offense, whether it occurs in one day, or over several days, will result in the student being transferred to the fully online cohort.**

**Face mask requirements** - Masks are required at all times. Including, but not limited to, school buses, classrooms, hallways, bathrooms, and when entering/ exiting the building during dismissal. Additionally, students must adhere to social distancing guidelines and follow directions to ensure proper spacing is occurring in said areas.

The design of the mask must adhere to the school dress code and cannot have offensive or obscene graphics that would disrupt the school or learning environment. Masks found to be in violation will be handled according to the code of conduct

Face masks must fit snugly but comfortably against the side of the face, be secured with ties or ear loops, include multiple layers of fabric, and allow for breathing without restriction. Note – Homemade cloth face coverings and scarves are acceptable. Traditional paisley bandanas are not acceptable.

### LOSS OF GOOD STUDENT STANDING/ CONSEQUENCES

All students will begin the school year with status known as “Good Student Standing”. A student with “Good Student Standing” may attend or be eligible for any school wide events or extracurricular activity offered by the Thomas E. Bowe School.

If a student receives a discipline referral that results in a consequence, in addition to the consequence defined in the discipline code, the student will lose their “Good Student Standing”. Loss of Good Student Standing means the student will be denied the privilege to attend all said events for the number of days explained in this policy. These days are immediately following the suspension. In the event an activity occurs when school is not in session (weekends or holidays), those days will count when determining the student’s Good Student Standing. Activities in this policy include the following (up to but not limited to): *wellness activities, PBIS school-wide rewards, Real Men Read, Battle of the Books, Renaissance, Building Men, Student Council, Let Girls Be Girls, band, orchestra, and choir; dances, field trips, field day, possible school assemblies, and any other special extracurricular activity that may be scheduled.* Administrative approval is needed to attend an academic activity such as after school tutoring or homework clinic. ***This includes the Sixth Grade Camping Trip and the DARE dance. More information regarding behavioral requirements for these events will follow.***

Loss of Good Student Standing for a total of 90 days or more in a school year removes a student from Good Student Standing for the remainder of the year. It also renders the student ineligible to attend field trips and after school activities for the remainder of the school year.
