Dear Glassboro Board of Education, Dr. Sneathen, & Dr. Silverstein:

I would like to propose a combined trip to both France and Spain during our GHS spring break in 2019. The eight-day trip would run approximately **Wed.** April 17th, 2019 through April 24th, 2019. My expectation is that students would only miss 1-2 days of school. The tour company determines the exact traveling dates much closer to the departure date. I would serve as the Group Leader of this tour of French and Spanish students at GHS, with GHS Spanish teacher Ms. Melecio at my side as a chaperone. It would allow our students to experience both cultures first-hand and the ability to extend their classroom learning of French and Spanish in a very real way.

Since I traveled last year, this year is the planning year and next year would be the travel year. The trip to France and Spain that is the first choice for our students is **Paris & Barcelona** through <u>EF Tours</u>. Students would be able to visit Paris. There, they will see Notre Dame Cathedral, the Eiffel Tower, Le Louvre museum, the Arc de Triomphe, the Champs-Elysées, experience a boat ride on the Seine River, and more. In addition to seeing Paris, the students will also explore the palace of Versailles. They then would travel to Barcelona Spain and be able to see Plaza de Cataluya, Plaza España, La Sagrada Familia, Park Guell, Las Ramblas, a Flamenco dancing show, the Barcelona Cathedral, and more. The tour would include: round-trip airfare, 6 overnights in hotels, breakfast and dinner daily, a tour director, guided tours, and walking tours.

For every 6 students that participate, one chaperone would attend. I anticipate a group of no more than 22 students. The trip will cost students **approximately \$3200**. Tip money, optional excursions, and departure fees are extra. My expectation is to encourage students to do school-wide individual fundraisers to help them earn some money towards their trip costs. In addition, we will organize a few fundraisers to help them raise their tip money for on tour, etc.

We plan to have a meeting of interest for students to give them paperwork to share with parents. Then, we will have one for parents and students in the evening. I have enclosed a copy of the EF Tour we will be participating in. There truly is no better opportunity for our GHS students to enhance their language learning and cross-cultural communication than by experiencing the diversity of France and Spain. Ms. Melecio and I appreciate your consideration of this very worthwhile experience for our Glassboro French and Spanish students. Thank you!

What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to France

Day 2: Paris

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Paris, the City of Light. During your stay you'll get a taste of Parisian style as you ride down the Champs-Élysées, an elegant boulevard packed with high-fashion boutiques. Pass the Place de la Concorde and the Arc de Triomphe and strike a pose in front of the Eiffel Tower. At the École Militaire, see where a promising young Napoleon launched his rise to power. I.M. Pei's iconic glass pyramid marks the entrance to the renowned Louvre, home to treasures like Leonardo da Vinci's Mona Lisa. Day 3: Paris

Day 4: Paris

- Travel by TGV train to Barcelona, an art lover's dream city and the place where masters like Miró, Picasso and Dalí flourished. During your stay you'll explore open-air plazas dotted with avant-garde gems, like the Plaza de Catalunya and Plaza España. Snap photos of the twisting spires of La Sagrada Familia and marvel at the landscaped greenery and playful Modernist mosaics on your visit to Park Guell. Flower vendors and street performers greet you as you walk the tree-lined Las Ramblas.

PARIS AND BARCELONA / 2018 SAMPLE TOUR SCHEDULE

Day 1: Overnight flight to Europe

Depart North America on an overnight flight to Europe.

Day 2: Arrive in Paris

Upon arrival at the airport the group should be prepared to wait up to 2 hours for consolidated groups to arrive. Transfer from the airport to the hotel to store baggage. Take public transportation into the city center for dinner at a local restaurant.

Day 3: Sightseeing of Paris | Optional Versailles

- Morning: Depart from the hotel and pick up the local guide for the sightseeing tour of Paris. The tour will include driving by
 the major sights in the city. There will be a photo stop at the Eiffel Tower and the tour will end near the Opera or Arc de
 Triomphe.
- Afternoon: Free time.

Add this in-depth excursion: Versailles

Continue with the bus and guide to Versailles. Free time for lunch upon arrival (1hr). Interior visit of the chateau (1hr) and free time to visit the gardens (1hr). Groups with more than 30 travelers will be split into two smaller groups. Return to Pairs where the bus will drop the group off in a central location if there is free time, otherwise the group will go straight to dinner. [Those not participating in the optional will have a free afternoon and meet at dinner].

 Evening: Dinner at a local restaurant. After dinner, the Tour Director may offer the chance to take a boat ride along the Seine River (for an additional cost).

Day 4: Walking tour of Paris | Visit Notre Dame | Visit the Louvre

- Morning: Take public transportation into the city center for a walking tour led by the Tour Director along the Seine River. Self-guided visits to Notre Dame Cathedral (45mins) and the Louvre (2hrs).
- Afternoon: Free afternoon in Paris.
- Evening: Dinner at a local restaurant before taking public transportation back to the hotel.

Day 5: Travel by train to Barcelona | Walking tour of Barcelona | Optional Flamenco Evening

- Morning: Travel by TGV train to Barcelona (6hrs30mins). Groups will arrive at the train station approximately one hour before
 departure. Luggage space is limited on trains; please pack lightly and have passport available for check-in.
- Afternoon: The Tour Director will lead the group on a walking tour to las Ramblas and the Barcelona Cathedral.

Add this in-depth excursion: Flamenco Evening

Attend a traditional Flamenco performance (1hr). One beverage is included for each traveler. [Those not participating in the optional will have free time].

Evening: Transfer to the hotel for dinner.

Day 6: Visit Parque Guell | Visit la Sagrada Familia

- Morning: Depart hotel to meet your local guide for a guided sightseeing of Parque Guell and la Sagrada Familia. The guided tour includes visits into both Parque Guell and la Sagrada Familia (4hrs).
- Afternoon: Free afternoon in Barcelona.
- Evening: Return to the hotel for dinner.

Day 7: Sightseeing of Barcelona | Optional Taste of Spain

- Morning: Depart hotel to meet your local guide for a guided walking sightseeing tour of the Gothic Quarter (2hrs30mins).
- Afternoon: Free time.

Add this in-depth excursion: Taste of Spain

Visit a local market to pick out ingredients for a traditional Catalan meal. Afterwards, learn from a professional chef how to prepare the meal. [Those not participating in the optional will have free time in Barcelona].

Evening: Dinner at the hotel.

Day 8: Flight home

Transfer to the Barcelona airport for flight home.

2-Day Extension

Day 8: Transfer to Bilbao via Zaragoza and Parhplona

- Morning: Board your coach bus and transfer to Zaragoza (4hrs30mins). Stop in Zaragoza to take some photos and grab lunch
- Afternoon: Continue to Ramplona (2-3h/s). The tour director will lead a walking tour of central Pamplona (45mins). Continue to Bilbao (2hrs).
- Evening: Dinner at a local restaurant

Day 9: Sightseeing of Bilbao | Visit the Guggenheim Museum

- Morning: Depart from the hotel and pick up the local guide for the sightseeing tour of Bilbao (2hrs). The tour will include
 driving by major sites, such as the Catedral de Santiago.
- Afternoon: Free time for lunch (2) rs). The Tour Director will take the group to the Guggenheim Museum for a visit with audio-guides (2hrs).
- Evening: Dinner at a local restaurant.

Day 10: Excursion to San Sebastián | Guided sightseeing | Visit Monte Igueldo

- Morning: Transfer to San Sebastián (1hr30mins) and meet local guide for sightseeing tour. The tour includes driving to Monte Igueldo to walk in the old town (1hr30mins).
- Afternoon: Free time for lunch and exploring San Sebastian before returning to Bilbao.
- Evening: Dinner at the hotel

Day 11: Flight home

Transfer to the Bilbao airport for flight home.
