Subject: sub nurses

Good morning,

I am concerned about the future related to lack of availability and dwindling of our sub nurse pool of employees. Due to sub nurse retirements or taking other nursing positions, we are left with one sub who is pretty consistently available and 4 more who have limited or very infrequent availability.

In March, we did increase the sub nurse rate of pay to \$225 per day. This was the first increase in more than 10 years. At the time, I had requested an increase to \$250 per day which would put us at a higher pay rate than Washington Township and Franklin and put use even with Delsea. We do have nurses that also work in Washington Township and Delsea and I would like to provide an incentive to consider us first.

I am planning to reach out to Shelby to see if she can advertise for sub nurse positions on websites such as indeed or career builder and I was hoping to possibly get board approval for the \$250 per day.

Aside from COVID,, I do have concerns about future lack of sub nurse availability which would have the potential to have buildings uncovered due to school nurse absences for varying reasons. I am trying to be creative and pro-active in efforts to avoid this.

I am attaching a summary of district sub nurse rates. While some are the same or less than ours, the school populations are smaller, like in Pitman. Washington Township is our biggest competitor for our nurse subs and with the size of the district there is typically daily work available for our subs. Two of our subs also work for Delsea.

If you think this is something that the Board would consider, I will put in the request for the Board and see if it gets approved.
