Board Action Requested: Seeking Board of Education approval to allow Ms. Melissa Callahan to cover the 3 social studies classes (Blocks 1& 3- Honors American History II and Block 4 American History I), taught by Mr. John Cino while he is away on the trip to Spain from April 11-26, 2014. Due to the calendar changes caused by the weather more of the trip dates are now falling on school days that were previously scheduled Spring Break days.					
Details and ramifications: Ms. Callahan is excited about the prospect of teaching these additional classes, as she only has one block this semester. She would need to be paid for the ½ day sub rate and the loss of prep cost for each of the 8 school days.					
Positives: The students will have a certified social studies teacher for their classes while Mr. Cino is unable to be there due to the trip to Spain. The students would have the same substitute over the course of Mr. Cino's absence which might not otherwise occur. This would provide consistency to them in his absence.
