Request Board approval for a Summer Enrichment Program serving students in grades K-8 (dependent on interest/student registration for program) that will take place from July 11, 2022, to August 4, 2022, Monday through Friday from 8:15-11:15. The program will be held at JHR School for students in grades K-5 and GHS for all other grade levels. The Summer Enrichment Program will run 4 days per week for 3 hours each day with a maximum of 14 teachers to service students in grades K through 8, and 1 administrator for grades K-8. Teachers will also receive 3 hours of prep time at the beginning of the program for planning and family outreach. Teachers will be paid up to 3.5 hours each day to allow for time to receive and dismiss students. The program will take place through in-person instruction and will utilize both district transportation (estimated transportation costs included in cost proposal) and parent drop-off/pick-up. The program will address learning needs and learning loss in both ELA and math for all students who register. Students will receive targeted instruction based on their individual needs to help close the achievement gap. Program will be funded solely through ESSER III funding. See attached for funding breakdown of costs.
