GLOUCESTER COUNTY VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL SCHOOL DISTRICT **TUITION CONTRACT AGREEMENT**

AGREEMENT dated this 8th day of September 2016, between the Glassboro Board of Education, in the County of Gloucester and the State of New Jersey (hereinafter referred to as the "SENDING DISTRICT"), and the Board of Education of the Special Services School District and the Vocational School District of the County of Gloucester and the State of New Jersey (hereinafter referred to as the "RECEIVING DISTRICT").

WITNESSETH

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The SENDING DISTRICT agrees to purchase educational services from the RECEIVING DISTRICT. The RECEIVING DISTRICT agrees to provide educational services to the SENDING DISTRICT in accordance with the applicable New Jersey Statutes and the rules and regulations of the State Board of Education. The specific educational services to be purchased and provided are described in 1a. below.
- 1a. The specific educational services described in this section or attached as an appendix to this AGREEMENT are to be provided for the resident pupils in grades 9 through 12 from the SENDING DISTRICT.

Law Enforcement

- This AGREEMENT shall be in effect for the 2016 2017 school year. The educational services shall commence on September 8, 2016 and terminate no later than June 30, 2017.
- Tuition charges, as part of this AGREEMENT, as well as the payment of same shall be made in accordance with the applicable New Jersey Statutes and the rules and regulations of the State Board of Education.
- The SENDING DISTRICT agrees to pay one-tenth of the tentative tuition charge of \$1,125.00 each month (50% of full-time tuition of \$2,250.00) less any prior year credits to the RECEIVING DISTRICT commencing no later than September 30, 2016 and continuing through June. The payments shall be due on the first of each month.
- 4a. In the event that it is later determined that the tentative tuition charge was greater than the "actual cost per pupil" as certified by the commissioner multiplied by the actual average daily enrollment received, the RECEIVING DISTRICT will return the excess amount to the SENDING DISTRICT no later than the end of the first school year following this contract year. The RECEIVING DISTRICT has the option to pay such excess amount or to credit such excess amount to the SENDING DISTRICT in accordance with the following payment schedule:

June 30, 2018 - 100%

In the event that it is later determined that the tentative tuition charge was less than the "actual cost per pupil" as certified by the commissioner multiplied by the actual average daily enrollment received, the RECEIVING DISTRICT will charge the SENDING DISTRICT no later than the end of the third school year following the contract year the amount owed as follows:

- 4c. In the event it becomes necessary for the SENDING DISTRICT to request that the county superintendent waive the payment schedule in 4b. due to hardship, the SENDING DISTRICT will immediately notify the RECEIVING DISTRICT of such request.
- The RECEIVING DISTRICT agrees to provide the SENDING DISTRICT with a monthly tuition bill and a monthly report showing pupil enrollment and attendance.
- In the event any dispute arises out of this AGREEMENT the parties will seek to resolve the dispute as expeditiously as possible. Except as may be set forth herein, the interests of the pupil(s) shall be of the foremost concern in resolving such disputes.

AGREEMENT dated this 8th day of September 2016, between the Glassboro Board of Education, in the County of Gloucester and the State of New Jersey (hereinafter referred to as the "SENDING DISTRICT"), and the Board of Education of the Special Services School District and the Vocational School District of the County of Gloucester and the State of New Jersey (hereinafter referred to as the "RECEIVING DISTRICT").

WITNESSETH

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

- The SENDING DISTRICT agrees to purchase educational services from the RECEIVING DISTRICT. The RECEIVING DISTRICT
 agrees to provide educational services to the SENDING DISTRICT in accordance with the applicable New Jersey Statutes and the
 rules and regulations of the State Board of Education. The specific educational services to be purchased and provided are described
 in 1a. below.
- 1a. The specific educational services described in this section or attached as an appendix to this AGREEMENT are to be provided for the resident pupils in grades 9 through 12 from the SENDING DISTRICT.

Career - Technical Programs

- This AGREEMENT shall be in effect for the 2016 2017 school year. The educational services shall commence on September 8, 2016 and terminate no later than June 30, 2017.
- 3. Tuition charges, as part of this AGREEMENT, as well as the payment of same shall be made in accordance with the applicable New Jersey Statutes and the rules and regulations of the State Board of Education.
- 4. The SENDING DISTRICT agrees to pay one-tenth of the tentative tuition charge of \$2,250.00 each month less any prior year credits to the RECEIVING DISTRICT commencing no later than September 30, 2016 and continuing through June. The payments shall be due on the first of each month. If applicable, the SENDING DISTRICT agrees to pay directly an annual non-resident fee of \$5,940.00 to the RECEIVING DISTRICT calculated in accordance with N.J.S.A.18A:54-20.1 and billed at \$594.00 monthly.
- 4a. In the event that it is later determined that the tentative tuition charge was greater than the "actual cost per pupil" as certified by the commissioner multiplied by the actual average daily enrollment received, the RECEIVING DISTRICT will return the excess amount to the SENDING DISTRICT no later than the end of the first school year following this contract year. The RECEIVING DISTRICT has the option to pay such excess amount or to credit such excess amount to the SENDING DISTRICT in accordance with the following payment schedule:

June 30, 2018 - 100%

4b. In the event that it is later determined that the tentative tuition charge was less than the "actual cost per pupil" as certified by the commissioner multiplied by the actual average daily enrollment received, the RECEIVING DISTRICT will charge the SENDING DISTRICT no later than the end of the third school year following the contract year the amount owed as follows:

- In the event any dispute arises out of this AGREEMENT the parties will seek to resolve the dispute as expeditiously as possible. Except as may be set forth herein, the interests of the pupil(s) shall be of the foremost concern in resolving such disputes.
